Scott May welcomed the committee members to the meeting of the Scientist Mentoring and Diversity Program for Medical Technology (SMDP MedTech) Outreach & Planning Committee. Scott mentioned the agenda was sent via email. Scott then invited everyone on the call to introduce themselves. Scott reviewed the agenda for the meeting.

Planning for the 2021 SMDP MedTech Training Session (Sept 25-29 in Minneapolis, MN)

All 2021 SMDP MedTech scholars will attend the 2022 MedTech Conference (dates to be announced) Toronto, Canada; it is requested that all 2021 Mentors attend too, including a half-day in-erson training session prior to and in conjunction with the 2022 MedTech Conference. ICPD will provide each mentor with full convention access, should they wish to attend The MedTech Conference. The Virtual 2021 SMDP MedTech program will be on September 27 and 28. The agenda is available on the attendee info page. The scholars and mentors will be invited to join SMDP for the 2022 The MedTech Conference in person. Scott asked Erin Leahy to give an update.

Erin mentioned that she is finalizing the details for the upcoming conference. It will be a hybrid event this year. There will be an entire week of virtual sessions as well as an in-person sessions in DC on Sept 27th and in-person sessions in Minneapolis on Sept 29 & 30. Erin shared that the registration is a significantly lower than they anticipated due to the delta variant.

 <u>Scholars - thanks to the selection committee; scholar cohort demographics; the scholar</u> orientation session was 10-10:45am PT, September 9

Scott thanked all of the selection committee members. We had great representation from all the sponsor companies. Each reviewer had 20 students to score. Scott asked Dustie to provide the demographics. Dustie shared that the cohort is comprised of 50% female, 50% male with 50% Hispanic American and 50% African American. Scott and Dustie both stated that we are always looking to find Pacific Islander and Native American SMDP applicants. Scott thanked Dustie and her team for a job well done on outreach and recruitment. Elisabeth added she excited to introduce the new cohort of SMDP Scholars. Scott stated that we are compiling the "Bio Book" of scholars and should have it completed by the end of the week. Allison asked if we had a breakdown of degrees. Dustie answered that 40% are undergrad, 20% masters and 40% PhDs.

We have already had one mentor orientation call on September 9 and will be having a second one for those mentors who could not attend on September 17. Scott thanked everyone for mentor nominations.

Scott added that at 6 months after SMDP most of the SMDP MedTech Scholars are ready for hire and 94% go to work in industry.
