PURPOSE, RESPONSIBILITIES AND BENEFITS

Purpose -

- The Gallus Advisory Committee is a standing committee for the purpose of working with the Gallus development team. The Committee is formed to give advice and recommendations to Gallus management.

Responsibilities -
