Scott May welcomed the committee members to the 2020 Scientist Mentoring and Diversity Program for Biotechnology (SMDP Biotech) Outreach & Planning Committee. Scott mentioned that the agenda was sent via email. Scott reminded the committee members that they could locate the agenda, past meeting notes and supporting documents for the meeting on the website <u>www.icpdprograms.org</u>, select "Committees" from the "Select an ICPD site" drop-down menu at the top right side of the page. Scott then invited everyone on the call to introduce themselves. Scott reviewed the agenda for the meeting.

Planning for the 2020 SMDP Biotech Training Session (June 6-10 in San Diego)

 <u>Contingency plan for the training session and virtual programming: ICPD will not be</u> <u>canceling the 2020 SMDP programs. In the event we are unable to conduct the June</u> <u>training session for SMDP biotech in San Diego, we will commence the year-long</u> <u>mentoring program virtually and will schedule an in-person training session, at a later</u> <u>date.</u>

Elisabeth shared the contingency plan. ICPD is closely monitoring COVID-19 developments. ICPD will not be cancelling the 2020 SMDP Biotech program. In the event that we are not able to hold

the in-person training in San Diego scheduled for June, we will commence the year-long program with a virtual introduction of the scholars and mentors. The in-person training will be scheduled for a later date. Elisabeth thanked the sponsors for their commitment to the program.

Scholar Recruitment – scholar application deadline is April 3; send names of selection committee members to Elisabeth Valerio at evalerio@icpdprograms.org by April 10; leadership added as a dimension for application reviewers; scholar orientation call is scheduled for May 14, 2-2:45 pm edt; recruitment for more Native American and Pacific Islander students; role of partner companies in outreach to students; partnering with key professional society list

Scott reminded everyone that the deadline for both SMDP Biotech and SMDP MedTech is April 3rd. Scott noted that the applications are tracking well ahead of previous years. Scott thanked those that have already agreed to be part of the selection committee and requested that all other volunteers notify Elisabeth and Scott by April 10th. Dustie added that the outreach team has worked hard at growing the list of universities as well as creating new contacts with professional societies. She is excited about the wide range of university representation from this year's applicants.

The selection committee will be asked to rate each applicant's materials using 10 qualitative and quantitative dimensions. A leadership dimension was added this year for leadership

The scholar orientation call will be held on May 14 at 2-2:45 pm edt.

Scott also asked for any suggestions from the committee on how to recruit more Native Americans or Pacific Islanders.

 <u>Mentors - notify Scott May of mentor selection by April 17; ICPD has received details</u> for 12 of the mentors so far; mentor orientation call is scheduled for May 14, 3-3:45 pm edt; new mentor primer

Scott noted that the deadline for mentors to be submitted to ICPD is April 17. Mentor orientation information will be sent in the next few days with key deadlines that can be conveyed to the executives that have volunteered to be mentors. Twelve mentor names have already been submitted. The mentor orientation call will be held on May 14 from 3-3:34 pm edt. In addition to the orientation call the mentors will be given a mentor primer. Elisabeth added that this is the 20th year for SMDP Biotech and it will be a very significant year.

 Scott thanked the committee for the speakers who have participated in previous SMDP training sessions. This panel will be an opportunity to have a representative from the sponsor companies share information about the emerging technologies on behalf of their companies.
